### Principles

At East Crompton St James':

- We ensure that teaching and learning opportunities meet the needs of all pupils.
- We ensure that appropriate provision is made for pupils who belong to vulnerable groups, this includes ensuring that the needs of socially disadvantaged pupils are adequately assessed and addressed.
- In making provision for socially disadvantaged pupils, we recognise that not all pupils who receive free school meals will be socially disadvantaged.
- We also recognise that not all pupils who are socially disadvantaged are registered or qualify for free school meals.
- Pupil premium funding will be allocated based on the identified needs of classes, groups or individuals.

### Impact

Impact from Pupil Premium funding 2013/14
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ In Year 1 3/8 FSM pupils met the phonics decoding levels which shows an improvement for FSM pupils compared to 2013</li><li>○ End of KS1 – All Year 2 pupils who took the Phonics Screening passed</li><li>○ End of KS1 – all FSM pupils achieved in line with their peers – 100% lev 2B+ in reading, writing and maths</li><li>○ End of KS2 – All FSM pupils achieved Lev 4+ in reading, writing and maths. 50% of FSM pupils achieved Lev 5 in reading, writing and maths</li><li>○ FSM Pupils now receive free extra-curricular music tuition where requested</li></ul>
