Please see below details of sporting activities which will take place during the next half term.

Dove-Shell Summer Sports Challenge

Each class will visit St Thomas' (travelling by minibus) to take part in a Summer Sports Challenge between our two schools – classes will compete in sports activities with the same year group at St Thomas' to score points. The Summer Sports Challenge Shield will be awarded to the school with the highest point score at the end. Dates for each class are below – Please ensure your child has their **school PE KIT (shorts, t-shirt + outdoor PE sweatshirt and trainers) in school**. Please also ensure your child has a water bottle in school and their asthma inhaler (if applicable). Depending on the weather they may also need a sun hat and have sun cream applied before arriving at school.
