## **Y4 linking visit to Castleshaw Centre**

As part of our ongoing linking project with St Thomas and Burnley Brow schools, we have arranged a visit to Castleshaw Centre in Delph on **Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> October**. The children will attend the centre during the school day and the visit is **free of charge**. The children will travel to and from the centre by coach and will be supervised by members of staff at all times. The coach will pick the children up just after the start of the school day and will return for 3pm. **Please ensure your child is in school on time**, so that they do not miss their trip.

At the centre they will have the opportunity to work with children from other schools to take part in wide range of educational activities in the countryside and find out about Roman settlement in Oldham. A packed lunch will be provided for children who have school dinners. Children who normally have packed lunches will need to bring their lunch in a NAMED disposable bag (no glass bottles please).

**Clothing:** As most of the activities take place outdoors, please ensure your child wears suitable clothing for the weather. They will not need to wear their school uniform but should not wear their best clothes as they may get muddy. Your child should wear jogging bottoms, trainers, warm socks, a t-shirt and long-sleeved top as well as their coat. If it is a cold day, please make sure your child wears a warm coat, as well as a hat, scarf and gloves if they have them. The Centre can provide wellington boots and waterproofs if needed.

Please complete the attached **medical/consent form** and return it to school as soon as possible. All information will be treated in the strictest confidence and forms will be destroyed at the end of the visit. Without a completed form children will be unable to take part. If you would like to discuss any aspect of the trip, do not hesitate to contact me.
