Re: Breakfast Club & Tuck Shop

Dear Parents / Carers,

Following the Governors meeting on Monday 11th February, it has been agreed that we will run a breakfast club in our school hall starting after half term. The club will open at 8:20am and will be accessed through Year 5/6 playground door. We will finish serving at **8:30am (prompt)** so children will need to be here before then. As mentioned in the previous letter, Reception class children will need to be accompanied by an adult but Years 1-6 may come on their own or with an adult. The cost of a breakfast including a drink will be 50p per child and 60p per adult. (Please note: children in receipt of Free School Meals will not have to pay).

Breakfast available will be – beans on toast, cheese on toast, egg on toast, jam on toast, cereal and milk.

Drinks available will be – hot chocolate or a fruit drink

After finishing their breakfast Key Stage 2 children will be sent outside to play until it is time to line up to come into school at 8:45am. **(Please note they are not supervised by staff during this time)**. Reception & Key Stage 1 children will stay in the hall with colouring activities until 8:45am and are then taken to class.

Children cannot come into to breakfast club unless they are having breakfast. Also, children in breakfast club may not leave the hall to wander into classrooms or other areas of school.

Just to remind you that our tuck shop opens after the half term holidays and will sell a small selection of cereal bars and fruit priced at 20p each. **(Please note: cereal bars will contain nuts or traces of nuts)**. The shop will open at 8:30-8:40am and will be situated in the corridor outside Year 5/6 classroom which can be accessed through the playground door.
